On the South wall of the temple is the idol of Durga. Durga is one form of Mahalakshmi. Sri, Bhu and Durga are the three forms of Mahalakshmi who is the Deity of both the manifested and unmanifested material world, also called 'Prakriti'. The three modes of the Nature - called 'Gunas', are under the control of Mahalakshmi. 'Sri' form controls the 'Satva', Bhu controls the 'Rajas', and Durga controls the 'Tamas'. When the ignorant and arrogant forces in nature, under the influence of uncontrolled superiority over 'Saatvic' forces, Goddess Durga is sent to punish those forces. She is also known as Kali, Chamundi, Sheravaali and many other names throughout India. In spirituality, we pray to Durga to overcome our 'Tamasic' nature and increase the 'Satva'.
