On the right side of the main Sanctum Sanctorum is the idol of Ganesh. Also called by many names - Vighneshwara, Vinayaka, Ganapati - Ganesh is the son of Shiva and Parvati. He is the deity of resolving the obstacles of 'selfless, intellectual and spiritual pursuits'. It is customary to pray and worship Ganapati before any Puja or Rituals. The head of elephant with big ears, symbolizes ability to gather knowledge, digest and analyze before any action. He is considered as the 'typist' for Sri Vedavyasa when the latter created the epic "Mahabharata".
